Preschool Sunday School

Sunday 9:45 ages 3 years thru 5 years

In May the children will celebrate Tucker, Camelia, Zoey and Lainey's birthdays. The children will learn how to worship in church. We will use Bible stories and songs to teach about Hezekiah and the people in church worshiping God, how Moses built a Tabernacle by working with others, how a widow gave all she had, and that people prayed for Peter.

The weekly lessons and Bible verses are:

May 4: Hezekiah and the People Worshiped (based on 2 Chronicles 29) Weekly Verse: Come, let us worship God. Psalm 95:6 When riding in the car with your child, play and sing the worship songs. Remind your child that Hezekiah and the people worship God by singing.

May 11: Building the Tabernacle (based on Exodus 35:4–36:37; 39:32-43) Weekly Verse: We will do everything God says. Exodus 24:3 Build towers and buildings with blocks or interlocking toys with your child. Talk about the people building the tabernacle. Mention things you and your child do at church to learn and work together.

May 18: A Widow Gave All She Had (based on Mark 12:41-44; Luke 21:1-4) Weekly Verse: Bring an offering to church. Malachi 3:10 Review the Bible story with your child. Sing to the tune of "Mary Had a Little Lamb": "People at church give offerings. / Offerings, offerings. / People at church give offerings. / They bring offerings to church."

May 25: People Prayed for Peter (based on Acts 12:1-19) Weekly Verse: Pray for one another. James 5:16 Say sentence prayers daily for many things. Help your child realize that he can pray to God about anything, anywhere. Pray as your child plays, thanking God for toys. Pray when you are in the car, asking God to help the drivers be safe as they drive. Pray for the mail delivery driver and sanitation worker.

After our lesson, its craft time, recite our weekly bible verse and pray.
